

Registration Committee Rules of Team Formation

-The registration committee is comprised of 1 representative from each sub-group. (currently there are 10 sub-groups)

-The club registrar chairs the committee and facilitates the team formation meeting and the player draw meeting.

-The club uses the guidelines established by the K.Y.S.A.

1. Players are rostered to a team in the age grouping based on their age as of August 1st of the seasonal year.
2. The number of teams formed in an age group and gender is determined by the number of players registered at the time of the team formation meeting.
3. The son/daughter of the Head Coach and one Assistant Coach will be rostered together and are considered protected players.
4. Players that were rostered together in the previous season and continue in the same age group will be rostered together. (this is provided they register by the deadline date)
5. Siblings will be rostered together.
6. Parents are permitted to ask to have players play up an age group; no player playing up will bump an appropriate age player off of a team. A request to play up must be indicated on the registration form.
7. Unprotected players, new players, and those registering after the deadline but before the player draw, will be randomly drawn to the team from their area.
8. Players registering after the player draw will be placed on the team with the least number of players in that age group.
